## THE HOUSE YOU ARE BUILDING

Because he wanted to help a poor carpenter and his family, a certain rich man decided that he would hire him to build a house on a beautiful hillside. The poor man accepted the job and, as the story is told, plans for the house were made and construction got underway. Not long into the project, the rich man was called away on business and would be gone for a considerable length of time. The carpenter reasoned that, while his boss was away, he could make a little extra money by choosing an inferior grade of material in inconspicuous places. The house would be less sturdy but no one would be the wiser.

At last the rich man returned to find that the work had been completed. The carpenter presented the house and the rich man thanked him for his work. Then, in an unexpected act of generosity, the rich man present both the deed and the key to the house to the poor carpenter, saying, "I am giving this house to you and your family." The joy of receiving such an unexpected gift was dampened by the realization that he had actually robbed himself and would now have to live in the house he had cut corners to build.

In the final analysis, we have to live in the house we build. Jesus compared such matters to a wise and a foolish builder, saying, "Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock. And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and slammed against that house; and yet it did not fall, for it had been founded on the rock. Everyone who hears these words of Mine and does not act on them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand. The rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and slammed against that house; and it fell—and great was its fall" (Mt. 7:24-27).
